

Church Government, Based on the Five-fold Ministry

Syllabus

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

An in-depth study on how the local church should be governed, incorporating the ministry gifts of apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers. Develop an understanding of God's anointings and gifts. See how unity can be maintained in the Body of Christ. Develop a picture of where God is taking His Church in the future.

I. Rational: Every church lives or dies, thrives or barely survives, based on its church government. In this course we learn how the government should be set up and then function in unity and power.

II. Prerequisite: None

III. Program Objectives:

A. Cognitive: The student will develop an understanding of the five-fold ministry and how they should function together.

B. Performance

1. The student will be helped in determining his/her gifts and calling, and hence, his/her own place in the body of Christ.
2. The student will be able to help set up church government and help the local church function more effectively.
