Institute for Hope and Life Victorious Eschatology Syllabus

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

A study of end times. We will be presenting differing views of eschatology, but favoring a view which reveals an optimistic future for God's people. We will study the relevant Bible passages, such as Matthew 24, Daniel 2 and 9, the book of Revelation, etc. We will discuss questions such as: What will happen between now and the return of Jesus Christ? What will happened at the final judgment?

- I. Rational: What people believe about the future influences their concept of God and determines how they act today.

- III. Program Objectives:
 - A. Cognitive
 - 1. The student will gain a thorough understanding of the major end-time views.
 - 2. The student will grasp the biblical foundation for an optimistic, victorious view.
 - B. Performance
 - 1. The student will be able to teach what he/she has learned.
 - 2. The student will be able to give a biblical defense to others for a belief in a victorious view of the future.
 - 3. The student will develop confidence in what God is doing in our times and the future.
 - IV. Preassessment: None
 - V. Instructional/Learning Activities:
 - A. The student will read the textbook.
 - B. The student will watch and listen to the 10 lectures.
 - C. The student will take and pass a 10-question quiz after each lecture.
 - D. The student will take and pass the 50-question final exam.
 - VI. Corrective Learning Opportunities: After each quiz, the student will receive a grade and then if performance is poor, listen to the lecture again and retake the quiz.
