2. The student will develop confidence to be financially successful.

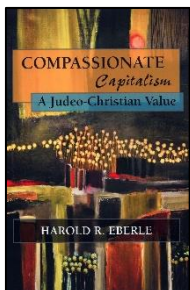
IV. Preassessment: None
